THIS CAUSE came on for trial during the August 28, 2006 civil session of Guilford County Superior Court before The Honorable R. Stuart Albright, Superior Court Judge Presiding, and a jury was first duly sworn and empaneled.

AND IT APPEARING TO THE COURT that upon completion of all evidence in Plaintiffs' case, Defendant moved for a directed verdict on all issues, and the Court was of the opinion that such directed verdict motion should be denied as to all issues and it was so ordered.

AND IT FURTHER APPEARING TO THE COURT that upon the completion of all evidence in Defendant's case, Defendant again moved for a directed verdict on all issues, and the Court was of the opinion -that this motion for directed verdict should be allowed as to Plaintiffs' claims for willful and wanton negligence on the part of the Defendant and it was so ordered; and the Court further being of the opinion that such directed verdict motion as to all remaining issues should be denied and it was so ordered.

AND IT FURTHER APPEARING TO THE COURT that Plaintiffs did not offer any rebuttal evidence. Thereafter, a jury charge conference was held and certain exceptions to the jury charge were made by the parties on the record in open court. Thereafter, issues were submitted to the jury that had been duly sworn and empaneled and answered by the jury unanimously as follows:

1. Was the Defendant a lawful visitor at the time and in the area where the dock levelers were placed?

ANSWER: Yes.

2. Was the Plaintiff a lawful visitor at the time and place of his alleged injury?
